

About the University of Mumbai



The University of Mumbai (known earlier as University of Bombay) is one of the oldest and premier Universities in India. It was established in 1857 consequent upon "Wood's Education Dispatch", and it is one amongst the first three Universities in India.

As a sequel to the change in the name of the city from Bombay to Mumbai, the name of the University has been changed from "University of Bombay" to "University of Mumbai", vide notification issued by the Government of Maharashtra and published in the Government Gazette dated 4th September, 1996.

The profile of this University carved out in 155 years of its functioning attests to its manifold achievements as the intellectual and moral powerhouse of the society. The University has always given its best to the country in general and to the city of Mumbai in particular by enthusiastically shouldering an ever-growing load of social values and opportunities.

Initially, the University concentrated its efforts on controlling teaching at the undergraduate level and in conducting examinations. Later on it took up research and the task of imparting instructions at the Post-Graduate level. This resulted in the establishment of the University Departments beginning with the School of Sociology and Civics & Politics. The independence of the country led to the re-organization of the functions and powers of the University with the passing of the Bombay University Act of 1953.

It has two campuses of areas 243 acres and 14 acres at Vidyanagari and Fort respectively; sub-campuses/centers at Ratnagiri 20 acres, Thane 6.50 acres and Kalyan 6.26 acres with 56 University Departments & Institutes and 691 affiliated colleges. It has established its name in industrial & International collaborations and runs various professional courses.

The University was accorded 5 star status in 2001 & 'A' grade status in April 2012 by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It has been granted University with Potential for Excellence (UPE) status by UGC and PURSE Scheme by DST. Many of its

Departments are recognized under various national programmes, such as UGC-SAP at various levels, DST-FIST, etc. At national level, it has excelled in sports, cultural and out-reach activities. In the last five years it has seen 104% increase in under-graduate students, 112% increase in post-graduate students and 147% increase in distance education students. There is 156% increase in the number of research papers published in International journals.

The University has always given its best to the country in general and to the city of Mumbai in particular by enthusiastically shouldering an ever-growing load of social values and opportunities.

This resulted in the establishment of the University Departments beginning with the School of Sociology and Civics & Politics. It has two campuses of areas 243 acres and 14 acres at Vidyanagari and Fort respectively; sub-campuses/centers at Ratnagiri 20 acres, Thane 6.50 acres and Kalyan 6.26 acres with 60 University Departments & Institutes and 749 affiliated colleges. It has established its name in industrial & International collaborations and runs various professional courses.

At national level, it has excelled in sports, cultural and out-reach activities. In the last five years it has seen 104% increase in under-graduate students, 112% increase in post-graduate students and 147% increase in distance education students. There is 156% increase in the number of research papers published in International journals. Twelve Department/sections are recognized under various national programmes, such as SAP/CAS/DRS/DSA/COSIST/FIST. More than eighty teachers are on various professional bodies. Eighteen National/International awards are won by teachers in the last five years. Every year about 20 teachers visit abroad for academic activities. Recently more than ten self-supporting courses have been started by the University.

It is now granted a Five Star status by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It has two campuses of area 230 acres and 13 acres, with 1.25 million square feet of built-up area, 22 thousand sq. feet of class-rooms and 84 thousand sq feet of laboratory space. It has two post-graduate centers, 354 affiliated colleges and 36 Departments. It has established its name in industrial collaborations and runs various professional courses. At national level, it has excelled in sports, cultural and out-reach activities. In the last five years it has seen 104% increase in under-graduate students, 112% increase in post-graduate students and 147% increase in distance education students. There is 156% increase in the number of research papers published in International journals. 12 Department/sections are recognized under various national programmes, such as SAP / CAS / DRS / DSA / COSIST / FIST. More than 80 teachers are on various professional bodies. 18 National/International awards are won by teachers in the last five years. Every year about 20 teachers visit abroad for academic activities. Recently more than 10 self-supporting courses have been started by the University.

University And College Rankings

Internationally, the University of Mumbai was ranked 41 among Top 50 engineering schools in the world by Business Insider in the year 2012 and was the only university in the list from the five emerging BRICS nations (Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa).

It was ranked 3rd best university in Asia in terms of graduate students as percentage of total students and the 2nd best Multi Disciplinary University in India by Asiaweek in the list of Aisa's best Universities 2000; with 8 of the top 10 Indian universities in Asiaweek's list being purely Science and Technology Universities.

In the year 2013 the University of Mumbai ranked fifth in the list of top ten best universities in India by India Today. It was ranked at 62 in the QS BRICS University rankings for 2013, a ranking of leading universities in the five BRICS countries (Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa).

Its strongest scores in the QS University Rankings: BRICS are for papers per faculty, employer reputation (20th) and citations per paper.

It was ranked 10th among the top Universities of India by QS in 2013. With 7 of the top ten Indian Universities being purely science and technology universities, it was India's 3rd best multi-disciplinary university in the QS University ranking.

The University of Mumbai has been given the highest ranking of five stars by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) In 2012, it was awarded a CGPA of 3.05 out of 4 and the highest rating ("A" grade) by the NAAC for its overall performance. The University Grants Commission also accorded the University of Mumbai with the status of "University with Potential for Excellence".

It was ranked 18th in the world for having the maximum Ultra High Net Worth Alumni Population. It was number one in the list among universities from emerging economies.

According to the latest survey report of 2014 by Wealth-X and UBS's "Billionaire Census", it has ranked 9th among the top 20 schools in the world that have produced the most number of billionaire alumni.

In December 2014, it was ranked 3rd among the worldwide ranking of undergraduate schools with the most alums at Morgan Stanley by American news broadcasting firm Business Insider.

The Thakur College of Engineering & Technology (TCET), a linguistic minority institute was established in AY 2001-02 with a clear objective of providing quality technical education in tune with international standards and contemporary global requirements. TCET is recognized by AICTE & Govt. of Maharashtra and is affiliated to the University of Mumbai. TCET offers 6 UG, 3 PG and 3 Ph.D. (Tech.) programme. TCET is accredited by NAACwith "A" grade for five years. Four UG programmes which include Electronics & Telecommunication (EXTC), Information Technology (IT), Computer Engineering (CMPN) and Electronics Engineering (ETRX) have been provisionally accredited by NBA for three years and are also given permanent affiliation by University of Mumbai.

Courses offered

TCET a NAAC accredited institute offers full-time programmes of four years leading to the award of Degree in Bachelor of Engineering (B. E.) and two year course in Master of Engineering (M.E.). All seats at U.G. and P.G. levels are filled-up as per the guidelines of DTE and Admission Regulatory Authority (Maharashtra State) applicable for minority institution with following distribution of seats:

- 51% for minority quota filled up through CAP rounds
